




Ireland: Population growth from 2011 to 2021 (compared to previous year)






Ireland: Life expectancy at birth from 2010 to 2020

Life expectancy at birth in Ireland 2020




Ireland: Life expectancy at birth from 2010 to 2020, by gender

Life expectancy at birth in Ireland 2020, by gender




Ireland: Average age of the population from 1950 to 2050 (median age in years)

Median age of the population in Ireland 2015




Ireland: Age structure from 2011 to 2021

Age structure in Ireland 2011-2021




Ireland: Death rate from 2010 to 2020 (in deaths per 1,000 inhabitants)

Death rate in Ireland 2020




Ireland: Infant mortality rate from 2010 to 2020 (in deaths per 1,000 live births)

Urbanization in Ireland 2021






Ireland: Gross domestic product (GDP) per capita in current prices from 1987 to 2027 (in U.S. dollars)

Gross domestic product (GDP) per capita in Ireland 2027




Ireland: Growth rate of the real gross domestic product (GDP) from 2017 to 2027 (compared to the previous year)

Gross domestic product (GDP) growth rate in Ireland 2027




Ireland: Share in global gross domestic product (GDP) adjusted for Purchasing Power Parity (PPP) from 2017 to 2027

Ireland: Share in global GDP adjusted for PPP 2027




Ireland: Distribution of gross domestic product (GDP) across economic sectors from 2011 to 2021

Distribution of gross domestic product (GDP) across economic sectors Ireland 2021




Ireland: Distribution of employment by economic sector from 2009 to 2019

Employment by economic sector in Ireland 2019




Ireland: Labor force participation rate from 2009 to 2019




Ireland: Unemployment rate from 1999 to 2021

Unemployment rate in Ireland 2021




Ireland: Youth unemployment rate from 1999 to 2021

Youth unemployment rate in Ireland in 2021




Ireland: Inflation rate from 1987 to 2027 (compared to the previous year)

Inflation rate in Ireland 2027




Ireland: Import of goods from 2011 to 2021 (in billion U.S. dollars)

Import of goods to Ireland 2021




Ireland: Import of commodities in 2020 (in billion U.S. dollars)

Import of commodities to Ireland 2020





Most important import partners of Ireland 2019




Ireland: Export of goods from 2011 to 2021 (in billion U.S. dollars)

Export of goods from Ireland 2021




Ireland: Export of commodities in 2020 (in billion U.S. dollars)

Export of commodities from Ireland 2020









Products made in Ireland: Perception in the year 2017, by country


Made-In Country Index: perception of products made in Ireland, by country 2017

Perception of products made in selected countries in Ireland 2017






Ireland: National debt from 2017 to 2027 (in billion U.S. dollars)




Ireland: Ratio of military spending to gross domestic product (GDP) from 2010 to 2020

Ratio of military expenditure to gross domestic product (GDP) in Ireland 2020




Ireland: Ratio of government expenditure to gross domestic product (GDP) from 2017 to 2027

Ratio of government expenditure to gross domestic product (GDP) in Ireland 2027




Ireland: Budget balance from 2017 to 2027 (in billion euros)

Budget balance in Ireland in relation to gross domestic product (GDP) 2027




Number of coronavirus (COVID-19) cases worldwide as of October 5, 2022, by country or territory

COVID-19 cases worldwide as of October 5, 2022, by country or territory




Number of new cases of coronavirus (COVID-19) worldwide from January 23, 2020 to October 4, 2022, by day

New cases of COVID-19 worldwide from January 23, 2020 to October 4, 2022, by day




Number of cumulative cases of coronavirus (COVID-19) worldwide from January 22, 2020 to October 4, 2022, by day

Number of novel coronavirus (COVID-19) deaths worldwide as of October 5, 2022, by country and territory


COVID-19 deaths worldwide as of October 5, 2022, by country and territory
